Sat Sept 3	Urris Hills from Dunree Steady ascent from beach to high point (417m) on ridge. May return via lakes weather permitting. 400m ascent / 8km / 4hrs	B
Sun Sept 11	Urris Hills Ridge from Lennan Beach Approximately 8k with 500m ascent, should take about 4 hours.	C
Sat Sept 17	Sperrins and Killeter Walking Festival We are encouraging members to support the festival. See: http://www.sperrinskilleterwalking.com/	various
Sun Sept 25	Altbritain Circuit Circular walk taking in Craigagh Hill, Spelhoagh, Oughtmore, and Mullaghaneany. Rough track, open hillside and forest track. Some sections may be boggy. 4.5 hrs / 11 km / 450 m ascent	C
Sat Oct 1	Club Trip to Majorca Open to club members only.	
Sun Oct 9	Aghla Mountain near Lough Finn Walking across bog and grassland. Steep ascent near the start. Circular walk with beautiful views over Lough Finn. 8.5km / 490m ascent	B
Sat Oct 15	Doochary to Fintown Approx 4 hours on rough way-marked track, some inclines and a couple of boggy areas. Please note - this is a linear walk so we will be leaving some cars at Fintown and car sharing the short journey to Doochary.	A/B
Sun Oct 23	Fairhead loop and Murlough Bay A loop walk taking in the Fairhead cliffs with an optional walk down around Murlough Bay 4 hrs / 11.5km / +/-420m	B

Sat Oct 29	MI Club Training Open to club members only.	
Sun Nov 6	Slieve Snaght Inishowen Boggy sections lower down, then steady climb to summit. Return via same route. 3-4 hrs / 7km / 400m ascent	B/C
Sat Nov 12	Falcarragh Loop Walk Walk starts at Falcarragh station and goes past the old Cashelnagor station to Procklis and then return to Falcarragh. We use a mixture of old railway line, bog road and quiet country roads. Great views of the Aghlas and Errigal from another angle. Just over 14k in length and should take about 4 hours.	B
Sun Nov 20	Lough Salt Mostly rough track. Boggy and wet in places. Should be free of high ferns at this time of year! Great views of surrounding Donegal countryside. 9km / 400m ascent / about 4 hours	B/C
Sat Nov 26	Circuit of Makoght Ascend Mackoght, then descend off Beaghy on north side. Traverse around back of Mackoght to gap between it and Errigal. (Option to climb Errigal if light and time allow). Return to carpark 11km including Errigal climb	B
Sun Dec 4	Curraghchosaly and The Robbers Table Go N to Curraghchosaly 416, then west round Ballynatubrit 318, then south to road . NI OS map 13. About 4 hrs.	B
Sat Dec 10	Lough Eske Loop walk on country roads and forest tracks. Great views, weather permitting. 12km/ 4 hours	B
Sun Dec 18	Roe Valley Country Park Further detail via WhatsApp closer to date of walk. About three hours.	A
